DUTIES:

- Serve as a Design Architectural Engineer, performing duties pertaining to facilities engineering management, specifically architectural engineering design and consultation services including engineering studies and project development, design analyses, computations, and coordination of in-house design projects, and technical administrations designs prepared by Architect-Engineer (A-E) firms under contract.
- The architectural type facilities and systems include but not limited to: operations, maintenance, administrative, bachelor housing, community support, recreation, and other special purpose facilities.
- Performs all aspects of work necessary for the development of all engineering aspects of work such as preparation of design analysis, drafting, cost estimating, project schedules, and other aspects of projects development and design.
- Evaluates design objectives, identifies most economical and efficient procedures for facility or the architectural engineering design and performance, considering all functional requirements.
- Coordinates all design phases with cognizant managers, other engineering disciplines, and staff elements.
- Utilizes architectural computer analysis programs and computer aided design and drafting systems (eg. AutoCad) for analyzing, designing, and evaluating appropriate architectural engineering systems and construction materials for various types of facilities.
- Provides post construction award services during the construction phase of projects.
- Investigates and evaluates contractor claims against the Government and recommends course of actions to the Facilities Engineering and Acquisitions Officer.
- Keeps abreast of emerging technologies, and applicable design codes and criteria.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Bachelor degree in Architecture or related field required. Copy of transcripts must be provided at time of application. Applicants may be required to provide evidence that education is from an accredited institution.
