

INSTALLATION UTILITIES COMMODITY MANAGER (Vacancy No. NAVFAC-MNL-005)

SALARY: \$24,738-\$38,129 per annum plus 25% overseas differential, meal/laundry allowance and year-end bonus. This position is employed by the United States (U.S.) government and identified as OG-0301-11.

LOCATION: US Naval Facilities Engineering Command, Far East, Diego Garcia, British Indian Ocean Territory.

DUTIES:

- Performs hands-on management and oversight of the utilities and energy programs for the installation.
- Implements installation criteria and requirements for the U.S. Navy Overseas Drinking Water (ODW) quality program. Manages, collects, and interprets drinking water data within the installation.
- Identifies deficiencies in the drinking water system, submits findings to the Regional Utility Commodity Manager, and works with plant operators or the requirements branch to implement corrective actions.
- Maintains and tracks drinking water related reporting requirements including but not limited to Sanitary Survey execution, Fit for Human Consumption determinations, Certificate to Operate submittals and analytical laboratory quality assurance program.
- Facilitates information sharing, coordination and distribution of technical data. Provides briefings, point papers, data analysis and input to senior management related to the utilities management program and requirements.
- Identifies and develops metrics to measure commodity efficiency. Analyzes utility trends and proposes remedial actions. Performs commodity management, including budget oversight and development of utility commodity rates.
- Develops and implements an integrated set of processes to minimize the life cycle costs of infrastructure assets, at an acceptable level of risk, while continuously delivering established levels of service for the installation's utility systems.
- Evaluates the installation's sustainment, restoration, and modernization program to ensure program is prioritized in alignment mission, safety, and environmental requirements.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:
